

CURRENT PROJECT GOALS

Total Project Cost: \$100,000

Project 1: Spring 2012

Build an Outdoor International Regulation Size Court

Currently the ISK basketball team practices on a court that is 1/5 of the size of a regulation court. This is not an easy task with 26 players. Building a regulation size court will allow the team to practice on a facility that will prepare them for game play. A court will also allow us to host games for other teams to play through league play, and it will eventually generate revenue for the ISK program. A new court will provide more opportunity for basketball to expand in Afghanistan.

Project Cost: \$15,000



Project 2: Spring 2013

International High School Girls' Basketball Tournament in Dubai, UAE

Since there are no other high school teams in Afghanistan for ISK to play, we have limited options about who ISK is able to play. Security risk place even further restrictions on games being played in Afghanistan. I have contacted a network of schools in Dubai, UAE to schedule a tournament that our girls might be able to participate in. This project cost involves air fare, visa, hotel stay, transportation, and food for our players. Some of our students have never been outside of Afghanistan. This trip would provide a week of experiences that would last a lifetime.

Project Cost: \$25,000



Project 3: Summer 2014

Attend Team Basketball Camps in the United States

The ISK players are in complete awe when they watch some game films from high school teams in the US. The ultimate project goal is to get ISK players to the US to participate in high school team camps at various high schools and universities. Players would spend approximately 3 weeks in the United States attending camps leaning from American players. This project cost involves, air fare, visa, hotel stay, transportation, and food for our players.

Project Cost: \$60,000
